Day to Day Itinerary

Day 1 Istanbul

On arrival you will be transferred to your centrally located Istanbul hotel. Istanbul is a place like no other; a mecca of architectural wonders, fascinating markets and strong cultural influences. Spend your day at leisure or head out to explore this cosmopolitan city.

Accommodation: Hotel Amira

Day 2 Gallipoli National Park

This morning you are transferred to the bus station for your shared coach to Eceabat. It is a long day on the road but the bus will stop near the city of Tekirdag so you can stretch your legs along the way. On arrival in Eceabat you will be transferred to The Gallipoli Houses, tucked away in the small village of Kocadere. The location makes it the perfect base for exploring the Gallipoli battlefields. Dinner is an unpretentious four-course home cooked meal using fresh, locally sourced produce.

Accommodation: The Gallipoli Houses

Day 3 Anzac Cove

Meet your local guide and visit the Gallipoli Peninsula, located at Turkey's most westerly point. Walk the beach and cemeteries of Anzac Cove then head up the hill to pay homage to the memorials of Lone Pine and Chunuk Bair. Around the Dardanelles area are remnants of trenches used by the Turkish soldiers. The hotel has provided you with a lunch pack so you can have a bite to eat at any time. Afterwards there is the option to visit the other battlefields of Helles or simply return to your hotel for the night.



Accommodation: The Gallipoli Houses

Day 4 Istanbul

This morning after breakfast you are transferred to the bus station in Eceabat for your shared coach service back to Istanbul. Your tour ends on arrival.
