Day to Day Itinerary

Day 1 Delhi

You will be met on arrival and transferred to your hotel in the heart of Delhi. The rest of the day is free before a welcome dinner this evening.

Accommodation: The Imperial

Day 2 Delhi

Explore Old Delhi, visiting Raj Ghat and the Red Fort. Ride rickshaws through the narrow lanes of Chandni Chowk and see the biggest mosque in India, the Jama Masjid. Your tour winds up in the aromatic spice market.

Day 3 Agra

On arrival in Agra you'll take private vehicles to the Red Fort, which stands like a crescent on the banks of the Yamuna River. You'll then be taken to a private vantage point in the Mehtab Bagh garden complex for breathtaking views of the Taj Mahal.

Accommodation: ITC Mughal

Day 4 Taj Mahal ~ Jaipur

There's excitement in the air as you rise early to see the Taj Mahal at sunrise. On the drive to Jaipur, stop at Fatehpur Sikri and take a rickshaw ride through Keoladeo National Park Bird Sanctuary.

Accommodation: Lebua Lodge at Amer

Day 5 Jaipur

As the ancient capital of the Rajput, the 'Pink City' is one of the most vibrant destinations in India. Take a private tour of the City Palace, Jantar Mantar, Hawa Mahal and Amber Fort. The rest of the day is at your leisure.

Accommodation: Lebua Lodge at Amer

Days 6 & 7 Nimaj

Built in 1733, Nimaj Palace allows you to experience Rajput hospitality at its finest. Enjoy cocktails near Chhatra Sagar Lake and return to the palace for dinner with the royal family. The following day you will visit local villages to learn about rural and farming life in Rajasthan.

Accommodation: Nimaj Palace

Day 8 Jodhpur

The city and its people live under the watchful gaze of the imposing Meherangarh Fort. Explore the fort after checking into Hotel Raas Haveli Jodhpur. Spend the rest of the day making your own discoveries.

Accommodation: Raas Haveli Jodhpur

Day 9 Jodhpur

The walled 'Blue City' is a blaze of colour and activity. Explore your surroundings then visit the nearby desert villages by jeep, including the Bishnois community. Take part in a cooking class then share dinner with a local family.

Accommodation: Raas Haveli Jodhpur

Day 10 Udaipur

Farewell Jaipur and set off on the drive to Udaipur, which is often referred to as 'The City of Lakes'. Stop at Ranakpur and pay homage to the 14th century Jain Temple on the banks of the Magai River. Continue the drive to 300-year-old Devi

Garh, your palatial home for the next two nights.

Accommodation: Devi Garh

Day 11 Udaipur

Welcome to one of India's most romantic cities. Visit the City Palace and Sahelion-ki- Bari (Garden of the Maidens) then share lunch at one of the most renowned restaurants in the area. Take an evening boat ride on Lake Pichola.

Accommodation: Devi Garh

Day 12 Delhi

After breakfast, there is time for some last minute shopping before your flight to Delhi, where your tour comes to an end.

Accommodation: Hotels listed are subject to availability.
